TESTING

1.3a

Each semester consists of in-person class times as described in **1.2** and internet based at-home tests. As reflected on the educational calendar, students have several days to study for and take each test. To receive credit, tests must be taken before midnight on the date shown on the calendar.

NOTE: Tests are not open book.

Tests are timed and are graded immediately upon completion.

NOTE: Once a student begins a test they must not attempt to or leave the test page. If the student does attempt to or leave the test page, the questions answered will be scored and that will be the permanent score for that test.

FIRST TIME ENROLMENT

The tuition and fees in this section apply to a student that enrols in BBI/FBI for the first time. This tuition includes a first time enrolment fee and pays for all textbooks.

ADDITIONAL FAMILY MEMBER

In addition to a primary student, all family members that enrol in BBI/FBI will receive a 50% discount on tuition. This dicount applies for every semester** and pays for all textbooks.

RETURNING STUDENT

Any student returning to BBI/FBI (or a returning primary family member) pays a discounted rate of tuition for all additional semesters in which they enrol. Tuition pays for all textbooks.

PAYMENT

Payment for tuition and fees is due at the time of enrolment for each semester. For the convenience of students, BBI accepts bank transfer, debit/credit cards (eftpos), or the pushpay app.

TERM INSTALLMENTS

Although the educational programme is very affordable, BBI is committed to helping all students. For those on a budget, there is an option to divide your semester payments into interest-free installments. This installment plan enables individual students and families with multiple students to pay tuition and fees in smaller, more affordable payments rather than in a lump sum.
